Role Title	Ward Visitor
Primary purpose of the role	Chat to patients to provide social stimulation and break up the boredom of being in hospital/waiting to be discharged.
Secondary purpose of the role	Support ward staff by serving teas and coffees to patients, topping up water jugs, and carrying out ad-hoc tasks as directed.
Where	Astley Ainslie Hospital
When	Morning, afternoon, and evening shifts available (Mon – Sun)
Tasks to be undertaken	 Visit the ward and chat to patients Serve teas and coffees Top up water jugs Offer to play games with patients (dominoes, cards etc.) Prepare cutlery and distribute before mealtimes Serve food at mealtimes (4:30 – 6:30pm shift only) Collect used dishes and cutlery for washing Ad-hoc tasks as directed by ward staff Optional: Take patients out for walks (after additional training)
Tasks <u>not</u> to be undertaken	 Providing any medical care Providing any personal care Feeding patients Manual Handling of patients
Skills, Attitude, and Experience needed	 Friendly, confident, and good at starting conversations Willing to bring enthusiasm to the role and be a self-starter Non-judgemental, empathetic, and understanding Patient, and sensitive to the needs of patients Reliable, punctual, and committed Ability to adhere to confidentiality Ability to adhere to all health and safety and fire regulations and co-operate with the NHS in maintaining good standards of health and safety
Mandatory training	Induction training
Additional training (optional)	 Small Talk and Communication Total Communication Wheelchair Manoeuvring Falls Awareness and Prevention
Support & supervision	Voluntary Services Manager (VSM) and Ward Staff.
