When	2 hours per week. Mon-Sun Mornings or afternoons
Tasks to be undertaken	<ul> <li>Tasks include:</li> <li>Complete with patient a consent form</li> <li>Provide short treatments of 15-30mins to patients such as hand massage or reflexology etc</li> <li>Chat to patients, making them feel at ease</li> <li>Reporting any issues with patients to staff</li> </ul>
Tasks not to be undertaken	The manual handling of patients, toileting or personal care.
Skills, Attitudes and Experience needed	<ul> <li>Recognised qualification in a Complementary Therapy</li> <li>Professional indemnity insurance</li> <li>Ability to provide short treatments</li> <li>Ability to put patients at ease</li> <li>Ability to maintain confidentiality and record keeping</li> </ul> Please note training will be given on all aspects of volunteering on an NHS Lothian site.
