Tasks to be undertaken	<ul> <li>Support the distribution of food and drinks to patients including giving out meals, snacks and refreshments, refilling water jugs, and checking and recording fridge temperatures</li> <li>Assist patients with their meals by cutting up food, feeding</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Assist patients with their means by cutting up rood, reeding patients and prompting as directed by department staff</li> <li>Support the cleaning up of dishes and cups following mealtimes</li> <li>Help patients to complete menu cards</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Chat with patients to help them stay mentally active and manage any anxieties caused by hospital stay</li> <li>Spend quality time participating in meaningful activities with</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>patients i.e., puzzles, games and jigsaws.</li> <li>Complete 'What Matters To Me' board near bed, which will create conversations</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Accompany patients to other areas of the hospital as required as directed by a member of staff (this can include pushing wheelchairs if manual handling training has been completed)</li> <li>Assist with fielding enquiries, directing families on the ward and enabling ward access through intercom system</li> <li>Providing patients with new pillows/blankets</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Assist staff with preparing beds for discharges and admissions</li> <li>Stocking up supplies and minor errands for staff</li> <li>Collecting and delivering pharmacy orders and lab samples as directed by ward staff</li> </ul>
